

### Well-considered

After the decision has been made not to have (any more) children, there are various possibilities regarding contraception. Some have a rather temporary effect, such as condoms, the pill, contraceptive injections, hormone implants and IUD. Other methods are permanent; sterilisation is the kind of treatment that provides a safe and effective solution. In this case, Ovabloc is the most suitable method.

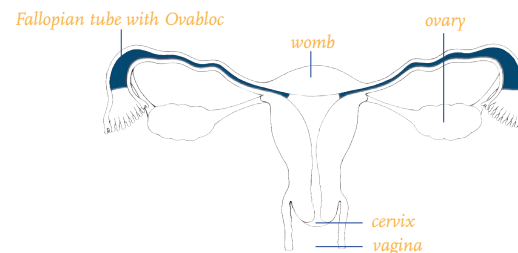

### Ovabloc, fast and reliable

Ovabloc is a treatment for outpatients, so that the patient can go home immediately afterwards. If so required, a local anaesthetic is applied to the cervix only.

### Women-friendly

The gynaecologist examines the womb, via the vagina, using a hysteroscope (thin tube with mini-camera). The tiny amount (0.15 g) of Ovabloc substance is inserted into both Fallopian tubes in the same way. The substance solidifies into a soft flexible plug within a couple of minutes, making the sterilisation complete. The positioning of the substance is closely followed on a monitor and checked using an X-ray. Daily activities can be resumed immediately after the treatment.



### An additional check, more security

The Ovabloc substance blocks the access to the Fallopian tubes. This prevents the egg and sperm cells from joining together. A second X-ray is made approximately three months after the application as a check. The use of another type of contraceptive is recommended during the first three months after Ovabloc has been applied.

### Reliable

Extensive scientific research and broad practical experience with Ovabloc (for over 15 years, with success) demonstrate the high rate of reliability. The chances of getting pregnant after an Ovabloc treatment are even smaller than the prevailing standard of 0.8% for other types of contraception.

### Permanent
